

Project Description

This project involved the reconstruction and expansion of Zion Triangle at the intersection of Pitkin and East New York Avenues and bordered by Legion Street in the Brownsville area of Brooklyn. There were several technical issues and complexities associated with this project. The proposed work included curb and sidewalk reconstruction, street lighting improvements, a new water fountain, bioswale work, landscaping, pavement restoration, signage and striping. It also included the restoration of the Zion Park War Memorial.
